There were no public comments.


FINANCIAL AND BOOKKEEPING MATTERS

Ms. Norman discussed an advance request received from Jefferson County Drainage District No. 7 ("DD 7") for DD 7's non-federal sponsor contribution for the Jefferson County Separable Element of Sabine to Galveston Pass to Galveston Bay (the "Jefferson County Project"). She said the General Land Office ("GLO") advanced to the District the funds necessary for such disbursement on September 9, 2024, and disbursement must be made to DD 7 by October 1, 2024, from funds

advanced to the District from GLO. Ms. Norman and Ms. Sunstrum responded to questions from the Board regarding the total budget and prior disbursements made to DD 7 for the Jefferson County Project. After discussion, Director Traweek moved to approve the disbursement of funds to DD 7 for the non-federal sponsor advance request. Director Mitchell seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.
